Things to consider when looking for an estimate

- How many parts do you want worked on? Some or all? Please be specific, we are able to do 1 or 2 parts or even a full makeover.
- Year, make, model. Because we work on any make or model
- What type of upholstery materials would you like? We can use 100s of leathers, Genuine Alcantara, or vinyls. Any of them as a solid or many different types of perforations. And we can make any of them look factory but of course it will be nicer.
- Do you have custom needs? Such as maybe custom colors, door handle courtesy lights, hydrographics for the trim ect...
- What's the current condition of the interior?
- Have the parts ever had polishes used on them? Polishes are very bad for interior parts health. It doesn't mean we can't or won't do work on them, its just needed to know so we can provide a more accurate estimate because we will need to pull that polish out of the parts before the rest of the work is done. If polishes were not used on the interior you don't have to make sure to say that, just let us know if the answer is yes
- Have any of the parts been painted before? If so, we will need to strip the color off so that anything we do will be done properly and this would be some additional labor as well just like the polish question so if the answer is no, there's no need to say anything. But if it yes please let us know.
